The minutes from the previous meeting were accepted as written.

We reviewed Derek's letter regarding our committee's response to the possible sale of Map 6 Lot 67. With a few minor typos to be fixed, the letter was accepted as written. We also briefly discussed what Ruth and Sherry found on a recent walk of this property. There were several areas with trash, such as a bed frame, tires, bricks. Also, near the back of the lot was a trail, possibly for off-the-road vehicles.

Matt has submitted his harvest notes to the Town and a copy is filed at Town Hall.

We continued to discuss the possibility of joining the Maine Association of Conservation Committees (MEACC). Matt had some more info on the association and he will contact the head of MEACC again to continue discussing possible membership.
