

Pownal Board of Selectmen
Minutes of April 4th, 2016

Workshop session with RJD Appraisers began at 6 PM.

Regular meeting called to order at 7:10 PM. All members were present.

Payroll Warrant # 65 – moved by Mr. Morris, 2nd by Mr. Anderson to approve as presented. SO VOTED.

AP Warrant # 66 – Moved by Mr. Morris, 2nd by Mr. Anderson to approve as presented. SO VOTED.

Department Head Reports – Chief Peters noted different prices for fit testing. He noted he is applying for a grant from the King Foundation. He noted a thank you letter received from the Humphreys on Poland Range Rd for quick and efficient response to a fire.

Road Commissioner Beaumier noted that they were working on grading gravel roads, in between little snow storms. Employees have been instructed to always display signs when the grader is in use. He noted prices and different methods of dust control. He is using a price of \$204,000 for the new truck. He note he had been to a personnel relations class.

AA Seaver noted that 6 foreclosure notices had gone out. Seaver requested that the Pownal Elementary School be used as voting place for the presidential election in November. Both Durham and Freeport had requested the same for their schools, and the RSU has scheduled a no school teacher in service day for that day. Motion by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Morris to use the school. SO VOTED. Seaver noted that April 18th was patriot's day and though there was a meeting that night, the office would be closed. He noted that nomination papers were due in to the clerk's office close of day on April 27th. April 20th has been set as public hearing for the back lot ordinance.
