Old business:

Matt shared with us a letter regarding a Town-owned lot (Map 8, Lot 9) that the Town received a request to sell. It is a land-locked piece off West Pownal Road near North Yarmouth.

Discussion continued about a possible trail behind the Elmwood Cemetery (Map 5, Lot 50). Sherry will contact John Mann again as follow-up regarding surveying. During a joint meeting with the Selectmen and the Recreation Committee, Tim Giddinge agreed that monies from the stewardship fund could be used to pay for a boundary survey.

Sherry has worked with Scott Seaver on our committee's report for the annual Town report.

New business:

Matt and Sherry attended the MEACC (Maine Association of Conservation Committees) meeting in May. They shared with us information they received at the meeting. Invasive species was one topic and Matt received positive feedback on our previous work removing honeysuckle from the Town-owned land on Poland Range Road.
