

Minutes of Meeting – May 4th, 2015

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM. All members were present.

Payroll Warrant #72- Motion by Mr. Morris to approve as presented. 2nd by Mr. Anderson. SO VOTED

AP Warrant # 73 – Motion to approve by Mr. Morris, 2nd by Mr. Anderson. Seaver noted a change in the total as a check would be voided as it was entered twice. SO VOTED.

Minutes of Previous Meeting – Motion by Mr. Morris to approve minutes of April 20th, 2015 as printed. 2nd by Mr. Anderson. SO VOTED.

Department Head Report – Chief Peters

Chief Peters presented bid prices on the installation of smoke alarm systems for each fire station along with annual maintenance costs. Motion by Mr. Giddinge to establish a separate article for Town Meeting to request the purchase and installation of alarm systems from Cunningham Security for \$6356.00. 2nd by Mr. Morris. SO VOTED.

Road Commissioner Status – Mr. Giddinge noted that he had met with the top choice for the position and toured him through the town. He expected to hear more from Durham regarding the position shortly.

Conservation Commission Appointments – Motion by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Anderson, to appoint the following as members for a term to expire 06/30/18: Derik Lovitch, Matt Welch and Ruth Hannan. SO VOTED.

Public Land Use Policy – Mr. Giddinge noted that he had one complaint and found evidence of the use of town land on Poland Range Rd. for target practice. He would like to review any policy on the use of land at the next meeting. Seaver will provide current policy and draft any changes.

Road Posting Extension – motion by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Morris, to extend the road postings on several dirt roads until May 15th. (Copy of list attached). SO VOTED.

Meeting on Single Lot Divisions – will be held on Thursday May 14th at 10 am here at Mallett Hall.

1-ton Truck replacement – Seaver provided specs used by the Town of Freeport.

State Assessment Ration – Motion by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Anderson to approve of the Agents suggestion of 50%. SO VOTED.

Selectmen’s Report for Town Meeting – Mr. Morris volunteered to undertake writing the report.

Dedication – Mr. Giddinge will undertake the dedication.
