



Town of Pownal Grant Application Policy

Purpose: To provide the Public guidelines regarding Grant Applications.

Approved at May 3, 2010 Selectmen's Meeting the following policy.


The Board acknowledges the importance and significance of seeking grants to fund projects and equipment. The Board appreciates the efforts of those who seek out these grant opportunities and asks that all grant requests be brought before the Board of Selectmen sufficiently in advance of the grant application deadline to allow the Board time to review the application and discuss it with the applicant. It is conceivable that this may take more than one week.

Grants shall not be applied for without prior review and approval by the Board, with the following exception: If the dollar value of a grant is \$1000 or less, if there are no matching funds required from the town, if no future maintenance costs will be incurred by receiving the grant, and if the grant application deadline is too close to go through the preferred process, then the Select Board liaison to the department wishing to apply for the grant may review the grant and decide on its merits on behalf of the whole Board.


The Board will also keep copies of grant applications on file at the Town Hall to be used as references, for research, and to be have a complete record of grants either applied for or granted to the Town of Pownal.


