Meeting called to order by Jon Morris. Also present was George Anderson. Mr. Giddinge was out of town.

Public Comments – Angela Horne presented a petition requesting that the Selectmen petition the MDOT to reduce the speed limit of 40 mph on Hodgdon Rd. She also suggested that 50 mph was too fast in the area Bradbury Mountain State Park. The Board requested that the petition for Hodsdon Road be submitted to the MDOT.

Department Head Reports – None

Special Town Meeting – tabled from previous meeting - Mr. Morris moved that the Tax Assistance Program for Elderly be placed upon the warrant for annual town meeting in June of 2018. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Anderson. SO VOTED.

Food Sovereignty Ordinance – Mr. Morris requested that an ordinance be prepared for Annual Meeting in June of 2018.

Road Commissioner Applications – Since Mr. Giddinge was on vacation, the Board decided to review resumes individually, and to wait until Mr. Giddinge was back in town to discuss.

Correspondence – Seaver noted an email from a lady whose windshield was chipped after Royal Road was chip sealed. He will look into the matter.

LRAP – Authorization and acceptance of MDOT LRAP funds in the amount of \$34,436 for fiscal year 17-18 was requested. Motion by Mr. Anderson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Morris. So VOTED.

Senior Volunteer Program – Mr. Morris requested that AA put together a possible ordinance that would pay senior taxpayers for volunteer hours dedicated to public service in Pownal.

Allen Road- Mr. Morris discussed calls and meetings with a resident of Allen Road who had placed offensive signs near his property regarding speeding on the Road. He noted that the Sherriff's office had been notified.

Lawrence Rd. – Mr. Morris noted that he had received 4 calls regarding deep ditching on Lawrence Rd.

Leighton Road – Mr. Anderson noted that grading work is needed on Leighton Road.

Special Meeting – a special meeting will be held on Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> at 4pm to review the tax commitment.
