

Pownal Board of Selectmen
Minutes of Meeting
Monday, June 4th, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm. All members were present.

Payroll Warrant – Warrant 82 was moved as presented by Mr. Anderson. 2nd by Mr. Morris. SO VOTED.

AP Warrant 83 – Moved by Mr. Anderson, 2nd by Mr. Morris. SO VOTED.

Minutes of previous meeting – moved to be approved by Mr. Morris, 2nd by Mr. Anderson. SO VOTED.

Dept. Head Reports – Fire Chief Peters noted some confusion on the CIP request. He noted the request is for Air Bottles, not Air Compressor. Road Commissioner Dick Clarke described activities of the department, noting that work was being done on repairs to Lawrence Rd., noted that the grader sensors seemed to be working correctly, and that dust control had been effective on Poland Range Road. The Grizzly had been delivered and some gravel had been purchased from Maxwell's pit in Gray. He noted that the highway congress was Thursday and all department employees would be attending.

Assignment of Town Meeting articles to Board members – was conducted and assigned.

PCWA Building Repairs – Seaver noted that one proposal had been received for \$5,375 from Vachon's Lawn and Carpentry Service. With unknowns in the roof, and any other complications, it was suggested that the project be award to Vachon for the bid price plus \$35 per hour for any other repairs. So Moved by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Morris. SO VOTED. Also moved by Mr. Giddinge, 2nd by Mr. Morris, to change the request to Town Meeting from \$20,000 to up to \$9,000, leaving room for additional repairs. SO VOTED.

Correspondence - Mr. Giddinge noted letters from MDOT regarding Park Project. He also noted complaints relative to a junkyard type of property on Verrill Rd. He also noted material that had been received about land spreading of a product on farm fields. Mr. Morris will review the material. Mr. Giddinge noted that building permits had been issued on Serendipity Lane without benefit of the roadway being completed. Mr. Anderson noted that there was no speed limit sign on the North Yarmouth end of Chadsey Rd. Mr. Clarke will check into that. Mr. Morris noted that he had been contacted by an individual who would like to meet with the Board after Town Meeting to discuss ordinance construction regarding the new Marijuana guidelines.

With no other business, the Board adjourned at 8:05 PM.
