ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Household metal goods
- Washing machines and dryers
- Metal wheel rims (no tires)
- Culverts
- Metal piping, poles, swing sets
- Empty paint cans
- Bicycles
- Lawnmowers
- Refrigerators & Freezers are acceptable (but need to be dropped in a separate location.)

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Items may **NOT** be plastic or wood they must be metal

- * Trash
- * Demolition Debris
- * Car Batteries
- * Chemicals
- * Oil, Gasoline or Antifreeze
- * Propane Tanks
- * Fire Extinguishers
- * Full or partially full paint cans
- * Chain link fencing, chicken wire, etc.

SPRING ROADSIDE CLEANUP

As part of Pownal Pride Day, we'd love to have community participation in a springtime roadside cleanup during the first two weekends in May. Plastic bags for this effort will be available at the Town Office (or use some of your own). We hope you'll do your best to have recyclables separated from the trash.

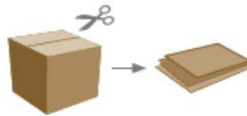
Curbside Container Placement & Cardboard Handling Guide



HELP US TO PROVIDE YOU WITH THE BEST POSSIBLE SERVICE

This guide illustrates the proper and improper placement of your curbside containers and offers tips with the curbside collection of materials.

CARDBOARD HANDLING

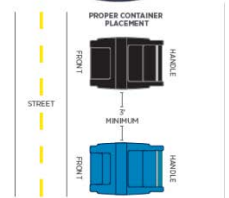


Please **breakdown all cardboard** so it fits into the carts with the lid closed. **Cut oversized material into 2' x 2' squares**



CONTAINER DO'S

- Keep containers on a hard, level surface clear of snow and other landscaping debris and no more than 6' from the edge of the curb.
- Please allow containers a 3' perimeter of clearance from obstructions such as parked cars, trees, mailboxes and utility poles. There must also be a 15' over head clearance from any low hanging tree branches or power lines.
- If you have more than one container placed at the curb, please set them side by side as indicated in the illustration with at least 3' of clearance between the containers.



CONTAINER DONT'S

Containers must remain upright for pickup.

Keep all material inside the container.

Do not place containers back to back.

Keep container clear of all obstructions.
