FIRE-RESCUE/EMS

Fire-Rescue/EMS has outgrown its 42-year-old station, and the trailer that houses its offices & sleeping quarters are in disrepair. The department needs meeting, storage & garage space to serve the community, and recruit, train, and retain staff & volunteers.

POLICE

Yarmouth Police need more space to accommodate its growing staff, & meet increasingly-complex law enforcement protocols. Police need secure storage for records, evidence & vehicles plus meeting space and other facilities to recruit, train, and retain staff.

COMMUNITY CENTER

Yarmouth Community Center has outgrown its current space used as the community center. It serves an important role for residents of the town, and needs updated, secure space to serve the community.

EMERGENCY SERVICES CENTER

Yarmouth Emergency Services Center where first responders provide local, state, and federal emergency services.

The facility will serve our Town's Public Safety & Community Service needs for the next 50 years



In the November 2018 election, Yarmouth residents approved the new facility.

Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2020. The new facility is expected to be complete by summer of 2021.
