Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm. All members were present.

Department Head Reports -

Public Works – Calvin noted that the repairs to Brown Road were completed and that Crooker will be paving soon. Ditching on Libby Road will be done next week, ready for cold treatment. Wednesday Don Randall will be out grading various dirt roads.

Administrative Assistant – Seaver noted that there was a meeting coming up with Durham at 6:00 pm this Thursday. He also noted the election on June 13th, Town Meeting on June 19th. Melissa will be out on Thursday for training.

Discussion on Alternative Tax Relief – Seaver had prepared a spreadsheet, and had really no confidence in the numbers on it. The proposal as presented by citizens at the public hearing was not allowed under current law. Mr. Giddinge noted that he has searched the legislative agenda and there was no mention of any changes that would make the proposal allowable. Seaver will put some talking points together for Town Meeting.

Meeting dates for the summer – Meeting dates were set for June 26th, July 10th, July 31st, August 14th, August 28th, September 11th and September 25th. Seaver will be out of town from July 14th through July 30th. Mr. Giddinge will be out of Town from July 25th through August 15th.
